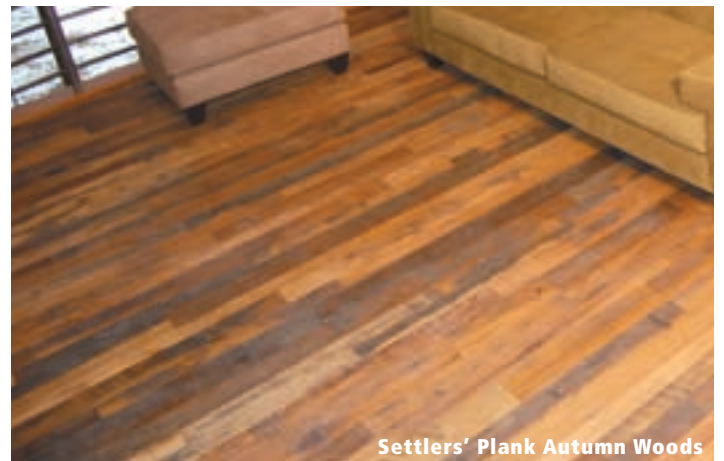

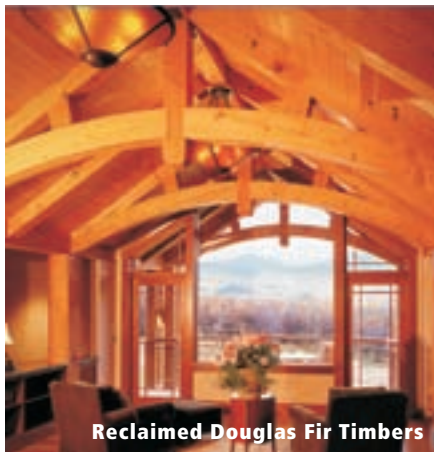

We are, if you'll pardon the pun, one of the pioneers of the reclaimed wood industry. Our doors opened in 1988 and we've since evolved into a 50,000 sq. ft. shop and nine-acre yard. Our wood comes from the deconstruction of agricultural and industrial buildings. First we remove the metal hardware from the raw timbers, a crucial and difficult task. Then the wood is resawn, graded, and prepared for its new life. The results are wonderful old growth patterns, highlights and character. With more than fifty species, grades, and specialty items available, we are the largest resource for reclaimed and sustainable flooring, timbers, and anything else you can think of to make from recycled wood.

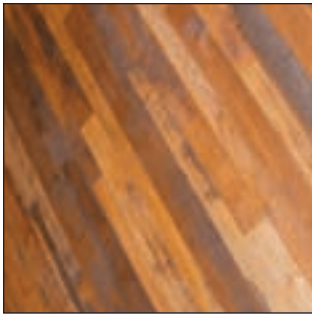

AMERICAN RECLAIMED HARDWOODS

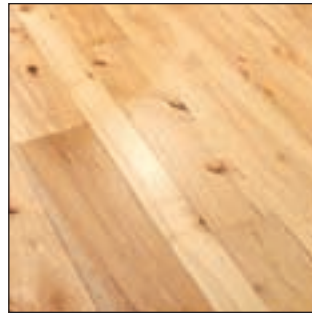

Settlers' Plank has a more rugged look as it is based on the classic barn floor. It has more nail holes, knots, saw marks and scuffs, plus highlights from the wood's natural vagaries. All of our reclaimed species are FSC certified.

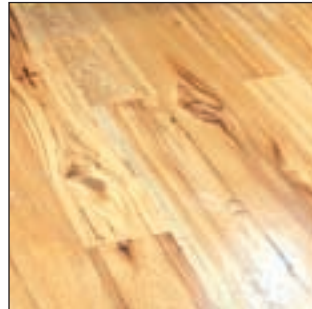

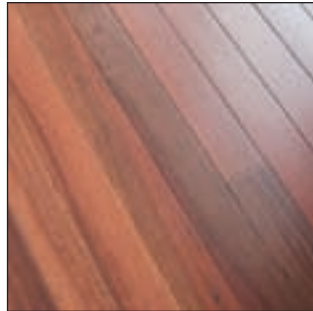

INDUSTRIAL HARDWOODS

Unlike most of our recycled wood, Boardroom Maple is actual flooring we rescue from factories. It's then replaned to reveal its bright character. Our Australian hardwoods are reclaimed from woolen mills and buildings "Down Under." These woods are stunningly beautiful, hard, and rot-resistant. As such, they are coveted for doors, stairs, furniture, millwork, and flooring. All of our industrial hardwoods are FSC certified.

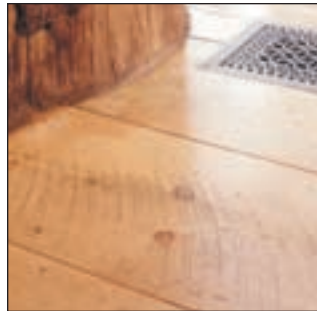

Grandma’s Attic — a mosaic of softwoods



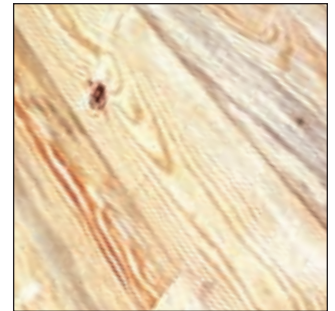

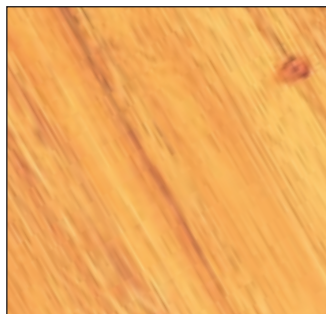

- Made fully in the USA

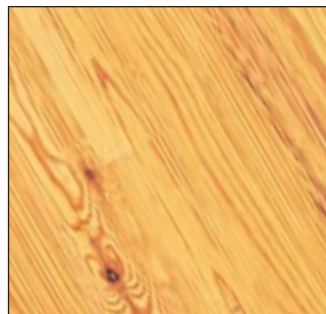


ANTIQUE HEART PINE

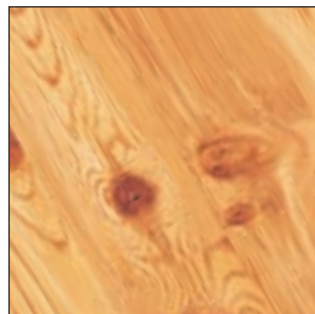
Longleaf Southern Yellow Pine, or what we call "Heart Pine" was so desirable that its 80 million acre habitat was almost completely logged off by 1910. We mill this wood from old industrial timbers. It is dense and resinous with plenty of character. Floors are durable and warm with dancing grain patterns and rich history. All of our Antique Heart Pine is FSC certified.
