Astoria School Gym Flooring—Astoria, OR



Salvaged from Clatsop Community College in Astoria, OR, this gym floor's original red, white, yellow green and blue paint lines have been reshuffled into a confetti of colorful stripes and marks. Like most gym floors, the material is a high grade of maple with an amber finish. The original tongue and groove remains intact.

From World War I era Patriot Hall

In 2015 Clatsop Community college replaced its old athletic facility with a modern and energy efficient building. The original building from which the floor was salvaged dated back to 1921 when it was originally part of Astoria High School. It was originally named Patriot Hall to honor local veterans of World War I.
