

# Standard—Larch Siding



Finish Color: Light Brown

Larch exterior shiplap siding is a great choice for those looking for a durable wood siding option that wears similar to cedar. This species is insect-resistant and moderately rot-resistant. It comes standard with a shiplap profile, and can be run either vertically or horizontally; its long lengths allowing for more coverage in one go. Our Standard Larch is harvested from British Columbia as a bi-product of logging. These commodity timbers are smaller, fast-growing and make for another sustainable option in our palette of exterior sidings.

Order it prefinished with a non-VOC water-based penetrating sealer to save time and money on installation. Our natural finish option will highlight the variations and grain of the Larch, or choose one of our color stain options.

## Why Larch?

Larch is an underutilized species with rot resistance greater than Douglas fir, an attractive grain, neutral color, and affordability that make it an ideal wood for siding products. Much of the Larch that we use is sourced from “standing dead” trees. Unlike Douglas fir which deteriorates after a mere 18 months after death, these 400-500 year old Larch trees remain remarkably pristine for a much longer time period. These trees yield some spectacularly clear and tight grain boards.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**Heartwood:** 75% Heartwood  
**Grain:** No restriction  
**Knots:** Sound tight knots included.  
**Texture:** Surface should be 100% clear of saw marks.  
**Voids:** No voids are permitted.  
**Discoloration:** Limited mineral staining is permitted.  
**Checks:** Structural checks not affecting the integrity of the plank, once installed, are allowed and more prevalent as the width of the material increases.  
**Moisture Content:** Kiln dried 15% prior to milling.

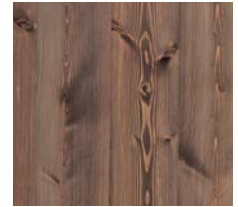

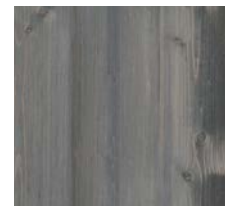
