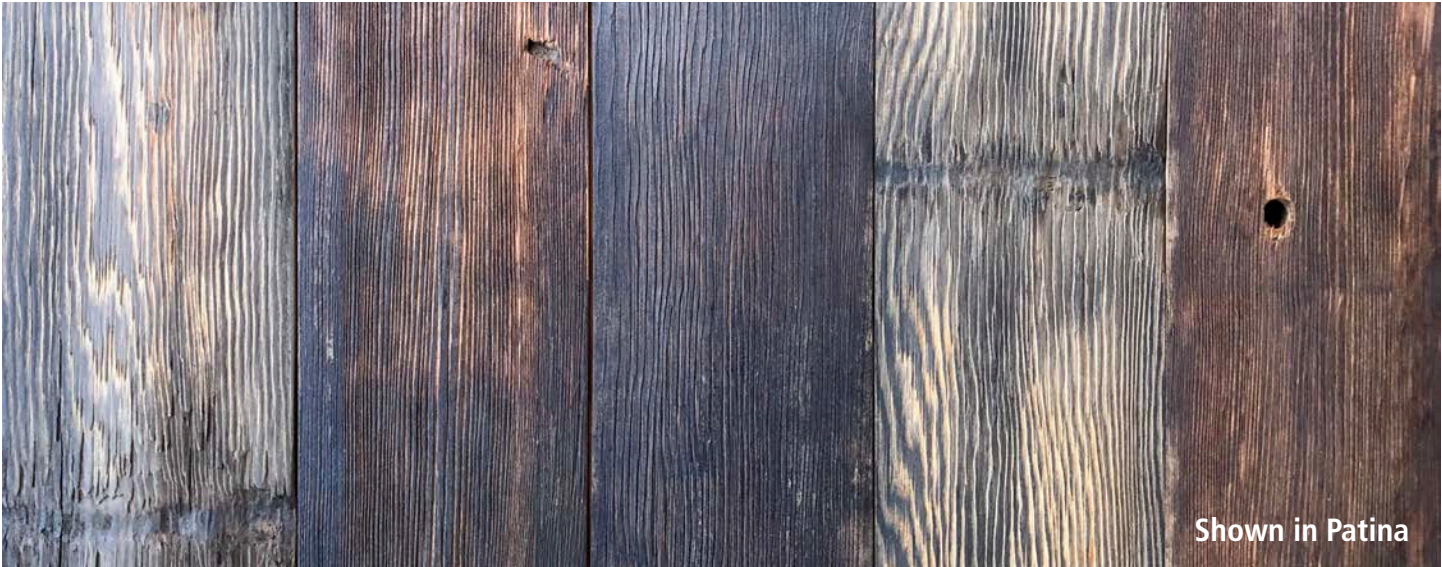

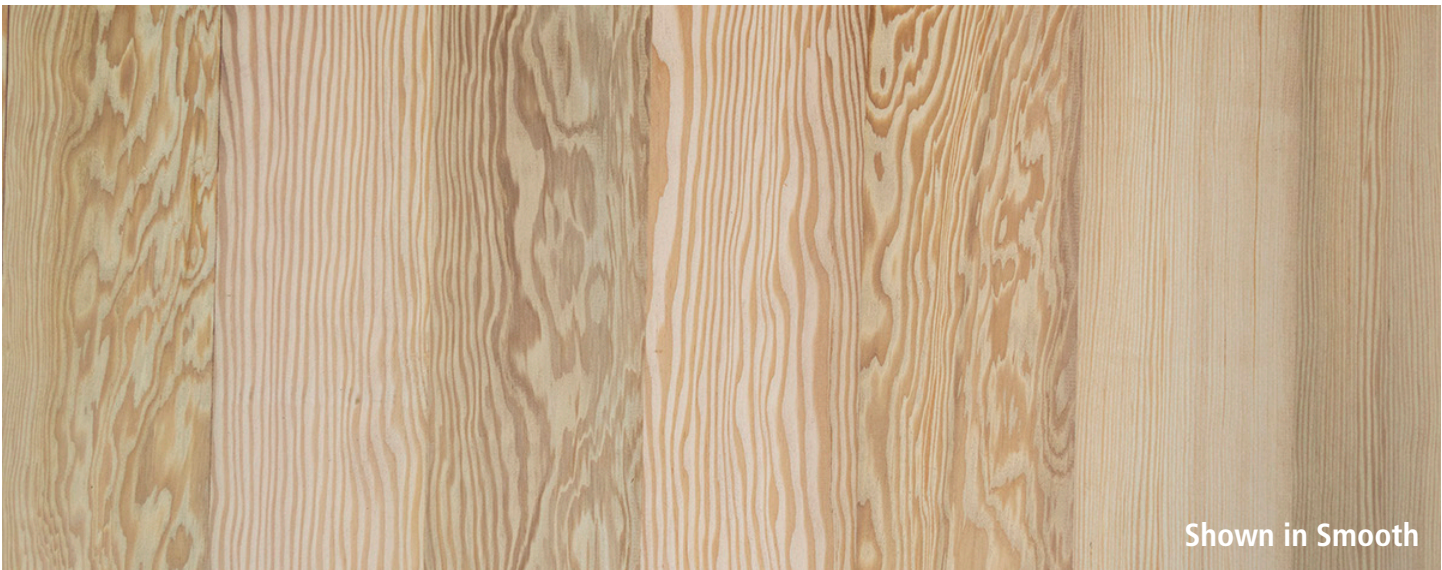
Salvaged from vinegar vats, this material is primarily made up of Cypress and Douglas fir and is available in two grades: Center Cut & Full Patina. The Center Cut grade is smooth planed, exposing the tight clear grain and the blondish-amber color tones of the wood. Typically, 10–20% of these planks will include some dark staining. The Full Patina grade preserves the original rough surface texture of the vat staves. These boards range from deep brown to charcoal in color and include occasional rust and deeply embossed marks from the metal straps which once held the vats together.

This fragrant and handsome material was sourced from recently decommissioned vinegar vats in upstate New York. These massive 19' vats were so large that they had to be cut in half before they could be safely disassembled. After decades of use, these vats have now been entirely replaced with modern stainless-steel tanks.
