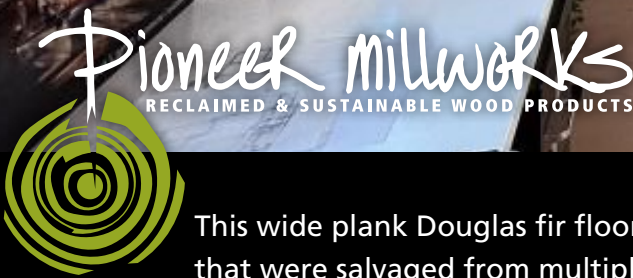


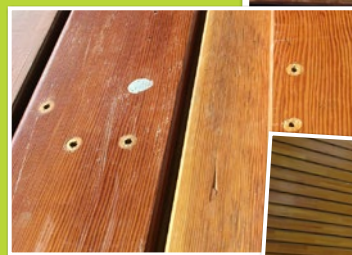
# Douglas fir Bleacher Board Flooring Batch #3325

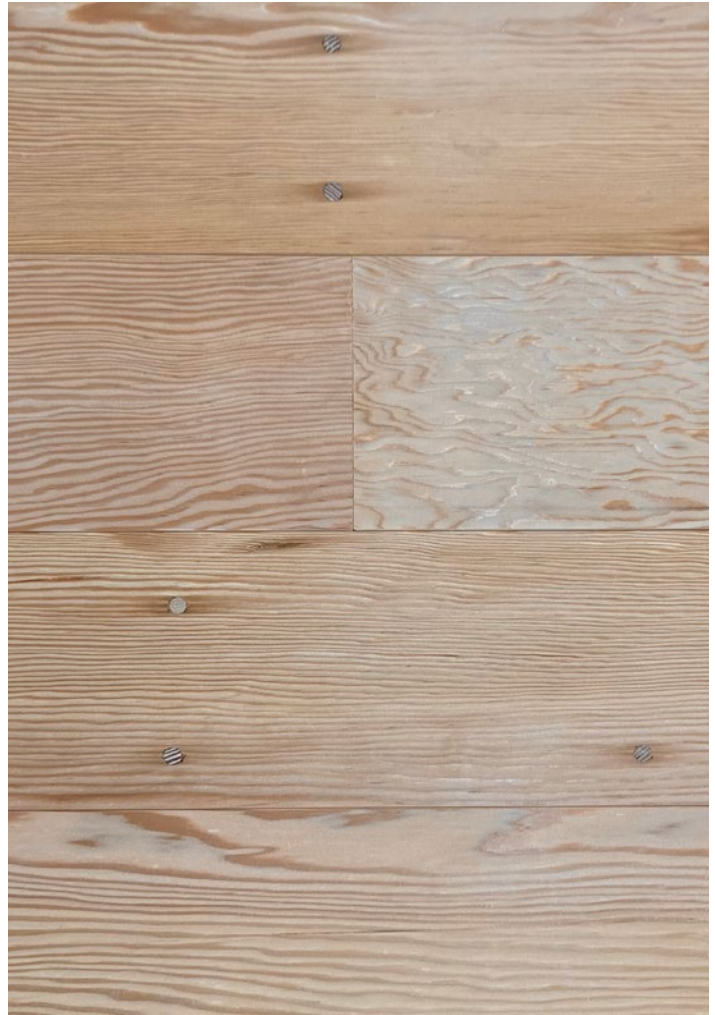


This wide plank Douglas fir flooring was milled from vintage bleacher boards that were salvaged from multiple gymnasiums across the country. We scraped off the old chewing gum, plugged the existing bolt holes, and fully surfaced each board to expose their clear, tight grain. This flooring is milled to a precision Tongue & Groove for easy installation. A mix of flat sawn and vertical grain orientations, this one-of-a-kind floor is a rare convergence of wide widths, long lengths, and clear grain with a unique reclaimed source. As with all of our Single Origin Batch products quantities are limited.

## Source Location: Various Gymnasiums across the country

Bleachers (also known as Bandstands) are raised, tiered rows of seating often found in Gymnasiums, schools, and educational settings.
