



Foundry Oak

Salvaged from a historic furniture warehouse in High Point, North Carolina, this hardy oak floor was underfoot for a century of manufacturing. Material within this batch varies in color from golden brown to charcoal grey and may include occasional paint, old machine oil stains, and a range of wear marks. A great choice for commercial applications, this floor's unique appearance adds an instant and authentic industrial character to any environment.

Source Location: High Point, NC

Dating back to the 1920's, this historic building was most recently occupied by the Haworth Seating Plant. Until its closure in 2021 the facility still had a working steam whistle and a boiler that heated the building with wood scraps. Following World War 2 it was estimated that 60% of all furniture that was made in America was manufactured within a 150 mile radius of High Point.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Heartwood: No Restriction

Grain: No Restriction

Knots: No limitations on sound knots.

Surface defects from chipped or open knots may be present.

Voids: Nail, bolt and other mechanical holes can be present and occasionally reach 3/8" in diameter.

Surface defects from insect marks, including pin holes may be present. Peg or bolt holes are often left open in longer planks.

Discoloration: No Limitation

Checks: Structural checks not affecting the integrity of the plank, once installed, are allowed and more prevalent as the width of the material increases.

Moisture Content: Kiln dried 6–9% prior to milling.

INSTALLATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Overage: Minimum 10% additional material

for on-site grading, trimming and installation factors.

Climate: As with any wood flooring or paneling product, the room temperature should be held at a consistent range between 60-80° F with relative humidity between 30-60%.

Environmental conditions consistently outside of these parameters could result in product performance issues.
